At the end of the month we had a fascinating talk by Mike Stone. Michael began his career in archaeology in 1980 as a graduate at the Institute of Archaeology, University College London, specialising in the Archaeology of Classical Civilisations and Architecture

The Thames Conservancy Dredging in the 1980s, cut through a ford between Kempford and Castle Eaton, resulting in hundreds of objects being spread along the river bank. Working with Swindon Detector Club, Mike recovered a wide range of both metal and ceramic finds.
