A Medieval silver Scottish farthing of Alexander III (AD 1249-1286), dating to c. AD 1280-1286. Second coinage. Long cross reverse. Pierced mullet of six points in four quarters. Probably Mint of Berwick.

A late medieval (1400-1500) silver gilt iconographic finger-ring
