Sevington Victorian School—an article by Mimzy

A few years ago I found a pewter achievement medal produced for Langley Burrell School and, last month whilst sorting through my finds, I decided to see if I could find anything more about it. This led me to the web page of the Victorian school at Sevington. I first got to see this school (from the outside) as a few years back as I was lucky enough to obtain permission to metal detect the surrounding fields.

The school was founded in 1849. Miss Squire took up her post as teacher just before her twentieth birthday

and continued to teach there for more than fifty years. When she retired, the schoolroom was left untouched and today we can still see how it looked in Miss Squire's day, complete with her desk, pointer and blackboard.

In for a penny, in for a pound I sent a message to the school asking if they could advise me on how I could find information on the name on the medal. In return I offered some of my Victorian coinage for the school if they were interested in having them.

At the beginning of July I got a guided tour of the school from Dinah Starkey the chairmen of trustees and it cost me less than a florin. In fact, 21 pennies & 3 farthings!


